SHARE closed its doors this year. To continue this Ministry, St. Chad's under the leadership of Rosemary Borel-Hull and to be assisted by Dixie White will soon start the Angel Food Ministries.

"Angel Food is available in a quantity that can fit into a medium-sized box at \$30 per unit. Each month's menu is

different than the previous month and consists of both fresh and frozen items with an average retail value of approximately \$60. Comparison shopping has been done across the country in various communities using a wide range of retail grocery stores and has resulted in the same food items costing from between \$42 and \$78."
